## HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION CONTRACT NO. HHS000114600001 AMENDMENT NO. 3

THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION ("Receiving Agency" or "System Agency") and the UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER SAN ANTONIO ("Performing Agency" or "Grantee"), collectively the "Parties," to that certain Opioid Emergency Response Pilot (TRG) Contract effective February 1, 2018 and denominated HHSC Contract No. HHS000114600001 ("Contract"), as amended, now want to further amend the Contract.

WHEREAS, the Parties want to revise the funding for fiscal year 2022;

WHEREAS, the Parties want to revise the Statement of Work and Budget to allow for successful completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Parties want to add a Special Condition to the contract.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Parties hereby amend and supplement the Contract as follows:

1. **Section III** of the Contract, **Contract Period and Renewal**, is hereby amended and restated in its entirety as follows:

The Contract is effective on February 1, 2018, and terminates on August 31, 2022, unless renewed or terminated pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Contract. The Parties may renew this Contract for one additional 12-month term, subject to mutually agreeable terms and conditions.

- 2. **Section V** of the Contract, **Contract Amount and Payment for Services**, is hereby amended to reduce the funding for Fiscal Year 2022 by \$5,500,000.00 dollars and is therefore amended and restated in its entirety as follows:
  - a. The total amount of this Contract shall not exceed \$37,850,436.00, as provided for in Attachment B Categorical Budget (Revised August 2021)
  - b. Texas Targeted Opioid Response (TTOR) funding is to be expended as follows: i. Fiscal Year 2018-2019, February 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019 \$7,375,000.00 ii. Fiscal Year 2019-2020, May 1, 2019 through September 29, 2020 \$13,042,410.00. iii. Fiscal Year 2021, September 30, 2020 through August 31, 2021\$11,466,513.00.
    - iv. Fiscal Year 2022, September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022 \$5,966,513.00.
- 3. Attachment A, Statement of Work (Revised August 2020), is hereby amended and restated in its entirety with **Attachment A, Statement of Work (Revised August 2021).**
- 4. Attachment B, Categorical Budget (Revised August 2020), is hereby amended and restated in its entirety with **Attachment B, Categorial Budget (Revised August 2021).**
- 5. Attachment D, Supplemental and Special Conditions, is hereby amended to add the following special condition:

## 9.22 Disaster Services

In the event of a local, state, or federal emergency, including natural, man- made, criminal, terrorist, pandemics and/or bioterrorism events, declared as a state disaster by the Governor, or a federal disaster by the appropriate federal official, Grantee may be called upon to assist the System Agency in providing the following services:

- a. Expand, increase, or modify service delivery in impacted areas;
- b. Community evacuation;
- c. Health and medical assistance;
- d. Assessment of health and medical needs;
- e. Health surveillance;
- f. Medical care personnel;
- g. Health and medical equipment and supplies;
- h. Patient evacuation;
- i. In-hospital care and hospital facility status;
- j. Food, drug and medical device safety;
- k. worker health and safety;
- 1. Mental health and substance abuse;
- m. Public health information;
- n. Vector control and veterinary services; and
- o. Victim identification and mortuary services.

Disaster related services may not commence, or expenditures incurred, until System Agency provides Grantee with a written Notification to Proceed. The contract may be amended to incorporate additional funds and performance or reporting requirements to support disaster services in the event services must be expanded, increased, or modified.

- 6. Attachment I, Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) Certification is hereby amended to provide the most recent Certification.
- 7. This Amendment shall be effective as of August 31, 2021.
- 8. Except as modified by this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Contract, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 9. Any further revisions to the Contract shall be by written agreement of the Parties.
